WHAT IS ALPHA FOR CATHOLICS?

Alpha for Catholics is about sharing the Good News in Jesus Christ. It is a program of evangelization. Over the course of ten weeks, Alpha provides a practical introduction to the Christian faith, offering guests an opportunity to explore the meaning of life in a relaxed and friendly setting. Alpha provides an opportunity for people to encounter the love of God in a personal relationship with Jesus Christ through the Holy Spirit. Alpha is biblically based and focuses on the Kerygma – the essential Good News of Jesus Christ, as preached by the early Church.

Alpha for Catholics Catholic is a gentle program of evangelization. For example, it never mentions conversion to the Christian faith. Instead, there are designed talks on the meaning of life and the basic sharing of the faith followed by conversations where any question and comment is welcome without judgment.

And each evening begins with supper. Alpha Catholic is built upon three pillars: Food, Faith, Fellowship
