

DAY 1: DEPART USA to MEXICO CITY

We depart to Mexico City. Upon arrival we are met by a guide who will escort us to our transportation for transfer and check-in to our hotel. Dinner will be at the hotel.

DAY 2: MEXICO CITY VISIT WITH METROPOLITAN CATHEDRAL

Our city tour will include the Metropolitan Cathedral where we celebrate Mass, the Great Temple of the Aztecs, St. Francis of Assisi Church, Torre Latinoamericana, Bellas Artes Palace and a walk through Alameda Central Park. We will stop for lunch at the Hotel.

During the afternoon we will visit the Anthropology Museum, one of the best of that kind in the world, and Chapultepec Park. Dinner will be on our own.

DAY 3: MEXICO CITY: BASILICA OF OUR LADY OF GUADALUPE

We visit the Basilica Our Lady of Guadalupe and the various points of interest in the Tepeyac area surrounding the Basilica, each associated with the story of the apparitions of Our Lady. Juan Diego's tilma is exhibited in the main Basilica. At noon we will have a **Solemn Mass** in celebration of the **Scalabrinian Jubilee Year** and **First Religious Profession of Novices** with a lunch to follow. The Scalabrinian Priests, Brothers, and Sisters will be in attendance. After lunch the bus will depart back to the hotel for preparation for dinner at the Scalabrinian Seminary in Tlalpan. **Dinner and Celebration with Missionaries and Seminarians at 7:00 pm.**

DAY 4: TEOTIHUACAN

We visit the world-famous Pyramids of Teotihuacan. Teotihuacan was one of the largest cities in the world housing more than 75 temples to the Aztec gods. Teotihuacan translated means: Place Where Gods Were Made.

We will have a late lunch together nearby after our visit to the Pyramids. After lunch, we return to our hotel for the balance of the day at leisure, and dinner is on our own.

DAY 5: COYOACAN & XOCHIMILCO

We will begin the day with a visit to Coyoacan. We will celebrate mass at the ancient parish of St. John the Baptist. After mass you will have leisure time to walk around the beautiful grounds of downtown Coyoacan. Lunch is on your own and you can choose from the many different food options available. This could be a good opportunity to purchase souvenirs if you so desire.

Afterwards, we will make our way to Xochimilco for a ride on a gondola style boat called *'Trajinera'*. These wooden boats are hand-painted in bright colors and float along an intricate system of canals. Each *trajinera* fits up to 20 people and there is a possibility that you can enjoy live mariachi performances while buying traditional drinks on the *'trajinera'*.

Festive dinner to follow to conclude our experience.
