On the Vigil of Pentecost, **Saturday, May 27th**, we would like to celebrate the many cultures that make up our parish and the universal Church.

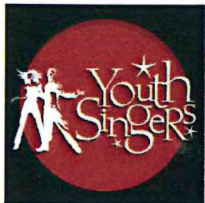
At the 5:00 pm Mass will include many of the languages spoken by our parishioners.
