**MESSAGE FROM FR. RICHARD ZANOTTI:** Since the Passover of the Jews was near, Jesus went up to Jerusalem. He found in the temple area those who sold oxen, sheep, and doves, as well as the money-changers seated there. He made a whip out of cords and drove them all out of the temple area, with the sheep and oxen, and spilled the coins of the money-changers and overturned their tables, and to those who sold doves he said, "Take these out of here, and stop making my Father's house a marketplace."

This is one of the few times that Jesus manifests his anger in a very dramatic way. We often look at anger as a sin and rightfully so but anger is a spontaneous feeling. As a spontaneous feeling it might not be a sin. If anger leads us to harming someone then what we do with the anger is a sin. If the anger leads us to correcting a wrong or some injustice then this would be an appropriate way to manifest our anger and therefore the anger would not be a sin. Let us always strive to express our anger in the correct way as was the case with Jesus in protesting the lack of respect for the temple. - Fr. Richard


