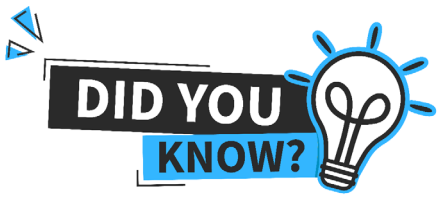
VOUNTEER CORNER
