MESSAGE FROM FR. RICHARD ZANOTTI:

Project Advance: I thank all those who participated in the 2023 Project Advance Campaign. Our goal last year was \$53,400.00 and \$68,752.00 was collected. After paying our portion of the expenses for the campaign we received a rebate of \$7,342.00.

The 2024 goal for St. Ann is \$55,100.00. We will begin the campaign on June 1st & 2nd.

In 2022 we collected \$103,890 with only 231 contributors. This was the highest amount raised since 2013. We need to increase the number of parishioners who can participate in the campaign. Any rebate money that comes to the parish will be used for projects that benefit our parish. In 2022 we painted the interior of the church and in 2023 we did upgrades to our phone system and computers. Together we can do great things with the help of God.

PENTECOST CELEBRATION: We will celebrate our Catholic Church at the vigil of Pentecost with a Mass May 18th at 5pm which will include a number of the languages of our parish community. After Mass we will move to the parish hall to share the different cultural expressions of our community through food, song and dance. We also ask parishioners to come dressed in their cultural garbs. Please call the parish office to let us know that you will be bringing food to share that day and also to let us know if you will be performing with regard to song and dance or any other cultural manifestation by May 6th.




