

GODPARENT - BAPTISM FORM

In order to undertake the office of godparent sponsor, each godparent needs to fulfill the basic requirements as stated in Church Law, namely:

- 1. the person must be at least 16 years or age
- 2. the person must have received Baptism, Holy Eucharist & Confirmation
- 3. the person must be at regularly practising Roman Catholic (the godparent must have their pastor sign the form saying that they are practising Catholics within their parish)
- 4. one godparent, male or female, is sufficient; but there may be two, one male and ones female.

Since a godparent needs to represent the Catholic faith community, a baptized Christian cannot be a godparent at a Catholic baptism but may be present as a Christian witness at the baptism.
