MESSAGE FROM FR. JAIME AGUILA

Trusting in God - To be a Christian, certain qualities are needed. To follow Jesus, to commit to Him, to leave the nets (so many nets that often envelop us), a man must have a special way of being. There is no need for special talent, or brilliant qualities, or to stand out for beauty or prestige. No. Nothing of the sort. What is needed is to be like Peter appears in today's Gospel scene:

You need to be a man - or a woman - capable of trusting Jesus. And this is not easy at all. It must not have been easy for Peter, a seasoned and experienced fisherman, to cast his nets in broad daylight, when he knew perfectly well that fish are caught at night and that night had been a resounding failure. It must not have been easy for Peter, and he said so in astonishment. But he cast his net. He trusted Jesus, who - Peter would think - did not know a word about fishing, and he was clearly demonstrating it. Fr. Jaime




REFLECTION
