

MESSAGE FROM FATHER RICHARD:

We are all saddened by the tragedy that took place last Saturday in East Vancouver. Families were out for the evening to enjoy music, dance and food, to celebrate their culture when a deranged man drove through the crowd at full speed killing eleven persons and injuring many more. The Lapu Lapu festival celebrates the bravery and resilience of the Filipino people initially against colonialism but today that bravery and resilience will need to be manifested anew after the tragedy that unfolded last week. We all try to make sense of what happened but there is no sense to it. Filipinos are a faith filled people, it is their faith as well as their deep family ties and their strong sense of community that will serve them in this time of shock and grief. We all join with our Filipino brothers and sisters in praying for the repose of the souls of those that have died, for consolation for those who have lost loved ones and for the whole Filipino community as it deals with this tragedy.

In solidarity with those most affected. Archbishop Miller has called for a special appeal to provide critical support for survivors and their families. In lieu of a second collection, St Ann's Parish will donate to the Archdiocesan fund to help meet immediate needs and ensure that ongoing healing and outreach services are available in the weeks and months ahead.


